BOGGS LAKE HEDGE-HYSSOP (GRATIOLA HETEROSEPALA)

Federal/California status: --/Endangered California Native Plant Society List 1B



Boggs Lake hedge-hyssop is a annual member of the figwort family (Scrophulariaceae). It has yellow and white tube-shaped flowers on a small plant less than 4 inches (10 cm) tall. It flowers from April to June.

It grows in shallow waters or moist clay soils of vernal pools and lake margins from Lassen County south to Fresno County. Within the project area, it is known to occur in Shasta, Tehama, Sacramento, Placer, San Joaquin, Madera, and Fresno counties.
